



The South Western School District Board of School Directors and Administration invite our parents and students to a community forum on Wednesday, June 13, 2018, from 5:30 P.M. – 6:45 P.M. The event will take place in the EHMIS Auditorium. The purpose of the forum will be to discuss the Board’s consideration of staffing all SWSD school buildings with armed school police officers for the 2018-19 school year.

The forum will feature Mr. Bob Gano, retired Pennsylvania State Police Sargent and owner of G-Force Investigations (www.g-forceinvestigations.com). G-Force Investigations provides all of our current school district security officers and would replace the security officers, if approved by the Board of School Directors, with armed school police officers. Mr. Gano will provide background and information on the training all school police officers from his team will need to participate in, and pass, in order to be qualified as an armed school police officer. District and building administrators will also be on hand to answer questions and gather input from the community to share with the Board of School Directors about this important topic.

The district is encouraging parents, students, faculty, staff members and other community members to attend this forum.
